Martha is a biologist - clinical embryologist with both clinical and research experience. Her clinical work amounts to more than 15,000 cycles to date.

Martha completed her bachelor's degree at the University of Essex, Colchester, UK in 1998. She completed her master's degree in Human reproductive Biology in 1999 at Imperial College, London, UK, graduating with Distinction.

She has received her basic embryology training at the Hammersmith Hospital, London until the summer of 2002. During that time she was also actively involved in the chromosomal screening of pre-implantation embryos for patients undergoing PGD/PGT-A using the *FISH* method.

In 2002 Martha returned to Greece and has worked as a clinical embryologist in both Athens and Thessaloniki, expanding continuously her knowledge and expertise in the field of assisted reproduction. Her main field of interest is the clinical application of PGD/PGT-A and severe male infertility (TESE, FNA and OAT).

In 2008 she became a member of the Embryolab team and since 2015 has been Deputy Laboratory manager. During that time she has also actively participated in the Embryolab Academy workshops (both in the organising committee and as an instructor) and in numerous publications and oral presentations.

Martha is an active member of ESHRE (European Society of Human Reproduction and Embryology) since 2002 and PEKE (Pan-Hellenic Association of Clinical Embryologists) since 2005.
